Directions to the UPPER NISQUALLY SPORTSMAN'S CLUB

From Puyallup (Hwy 512): Go south on South Meridian (Hwy 161) about 20 miles. Just as you enter Eatonville, turn left onto Lynch Creek Rd.

From US Route 12: Go north on Hwy 7, through Elbe, follow signs to Hwy 161 to Eatonville. Go through town (there is a right at a stop sign to stay on Hwy 161), make a right on Lynch Creek road towards the end of town.

Once on Lynch Creek Rd: Follow airport signs (stay on Lynch Creek Rd), cross over railroad tracks and the road will split. Stay to the left. The gun club will be at the end of the road. The asphalt road will end at the club, follow the road as it becomes gravel through the club, continue up the gravel road up hill for some ways to the camp.

Additional Important Requirements:

All attending Outposts must have a Permission to Participate & Emergency Medical Release forms for everyone under the age of 18 years.

Northwest District Essential Directive #14 must be followed. Each Outpost MUST present a Certificate of Compliance covering every adult present. Get these forms from your church.
